

# 2017 Motor-Mall (IOM) Manx Rally Championship

Promoted by Druidale Motor Club Limited and Manx Auto Sport Limited

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## 1. Announcements

- 1.1 The Motor-Mall (IOM) Manx Rally Championship (“the Championship”) is promoted and administered jointly by Manx Auto Sport and Druidale Motor Club and consists of a Championship title for Overall Driver and Co-Driver. There are awards in each of the five classes and the Championship also features Junior and Team awards.
- 1.2 The Championship is governed in accordance with the regulations of the Motor Sports Association (MSA) and these Championship Regulations.
- 1.3 The Organisers reserve the right to add or amend qualifying events and/or dates as necessary, subject to MSA Blue Book regulation D11.
- 1.4 The Organisers of the qualifying events retain the sole right to select and accept entries. The Championship promoters cannot be held responsible for the refusal of an entry.
- 1.5 It is the Competitors responsibility to obtain qualifying event regulations and apply for entries.
- 1.6 The Organisers reserve the right to issue additional information clarifying items in or relating to these regulations. All such information will be issued in an official bulletin which will be sent to all registered competitors.
- 1.7 Points and positions will be published shortly after each event on the Championship website, [www.manxrallychampionship.com](http://www.manxrallychampionship.com), and may additionally be sent to all registered competitors to their registered e-mail address.
- 1.8 The Championship points will be awarded as per the details in Article 5. Individual event organisers may sub-divide, amalgamate or alter classes as per their event regulations.

## 4. Registration

- 4.1 All Competitors must register for the Championship by completing the Registration Form and returning it to the Championship Coordinator or by submitting an online Registration Form from [www.manxrallychampionship.com](http://www.manxrallychampionship.com), prior to the end of Documentation of the event they wish to score from as defined in the event regulations.
- 4.2 Only members of either Manx Auto Sport or Druidale Motor Club may be registered as competitors for the Championship.
- 4.3 Registration for the Championship will close at the end of Documentation for the fourth round of the Championship.
- 4.4 All accepted registrations will be confirmed by a registration card. This will be deemed final in establishing a competitor's eligibility and for points scoring purposes. A current list of registered competitors will be located on the official event notice board at each qualifying round and also on the Championship website.
- 4.5 Registered competitors may not disclaim or transfer points scored on any qualifying round.

## 5. Eligibility

- 5.1 Championship eligibility will be checked on each qualifying event.
- 5.2 Mandatory Championship advertising should be displayed on each competing car at scrutineering and for the duration of each qualifying round of the Championship.
- 5.3 Failure to display correctly the Championship compulsory advertising referred to in Appendix I may be penalised at the discretion of the Championship Stewards.
- 5.4 Championship decals will be available prior to events from the Championship Co-ordinator and on events from a Championship Representative.
- 5.5 It is the competitor's responsibility to obtain championship decals.

### 5.6 Vehicle Classes

Class A	up to and including 1400cc
Class B	Over 1400cc and up to and including 1600cc
Class C	Over 1600cc and up to and including 2000cc
Class D	Over 2000cc and up to and including 3000cc
Class E	Over 3000cc 4WD & Turbo powered cars

Cars fitted with forced-induction systems and/or rotary engines will be classified as having an engine capacity increase of 70% in accordance with MSA regulation J5.4.1.

- 5.7 FUEL – The Championship has been granted permission for competitors to use pump fuels complying with FIA, Appendix J, Article 252, Art 9.

## 6. Scoring

### 6.1 The Manx Rally Championship (Overall and Class)

- 6.1.1 This section is open to all registered competitors competing in eligible vehicles that comply with Article 5.6

- 6.1.2 Points will be allocated to the highest placed registered competitor in final overall classification on each round as follows:-

Highest placed - 30 points  
Second highest - 27 points  
Third highest - 25 points  
Fourth highest - 24 points

And so on deleting one point per placing down to two points for 26<sup>th</sup> place and every subsequent finisher. One point will be awarded to every non-finisher.

Bonus points will be added to the overall point's scores of all registered competitors that finish the event as follows: Class E = 1 point, Class C & D = 2, Class B =3 and Class A = 4.

- 6.1.3 Points will be allocated to the highest placed registered competitor in their final class classification on each round as follows:-

Highest placed - 15 points  
Second highest - 12 points  
Third highest - 10 points  
Fourth highest - 9 points

And so on deleting one point per placing down to a minimum of two points for 11th awarded and every subsequent finisher. One point will be awarded to every non-finisher.

- 6.1.4 The event result for the Manx National Rally will be declared at the end of the National B section merged with results of the National A section to that point.
- 6.1.5 On Rally Isle of Man, a set of classified results for the overall and class finishing positions will be published separately for each of the two scoring sections; these will be confirmed in a bulletin as soon as the event schedule is announced. Similarly, should the event include more than one permitted event then the events that will qualify as Championship rounds will be confirmed on or before publication of the event Additional Supplementary Regulations (ASRs). Registered competitors are eligible to score points in accordance with the point's allocation in Article 6.1.2 and 6.1.3

6.1.6 Registered Competitors are eligible to score points on all rounds of the championship.

6.1.7 Registered competitors must discount their single lowest score counting towards their final overall and class Championship classifications.

Should two or more rounds be cancelled competitors will count all scores.

Non-starts and non-finishes are counted as zero scores.

6.1.8 An event that is cancelled will not be classed as a possible event.

6.1.9 No points will be awarded retrospectively and/or discounted points scored in one Championship or class cannot be transferred/amalgamated to another.

6.1.10 To be eligible for end of year class awards, a Driver/Co-Driver should have started at least 50% of the events run during the year, in the relevant class as a competing Driver/Co-Driver. However, should no one meet these criteria, the organising clubs reserve the right to allocate the Award to the competitor with the highest number of points.

## 6.2 **Teams Championship (Sponsors Cup)**

6.2.1 This section is open to teams registering in the name of no more than two trading entities only.

6.2.2 The promoters retain the right to reject, request amendment to, or amend themselves team names that do not fulfil this criteria, or that they consider to be inappropriate.

6.2.3 All registered teams with cars which currently comply with Article 5.6 and Competitors registered in accordance with Article 3.1 are eligible to score points on each round.

6.2.4 Teams must be registered with the Championship Co-ordinator prior to the end of documentation of the event they wish to score points from.

6.2.5 Registered teams can nominate a maximum of 3 drivers.

6.2.6 Points will be allocated to the two highest placed registered competitors from each team in final overall classification on each round as follows:-

Highest placed - 30 points

Second highest - 27 points

Third highest - 25 points

Fourth highest - 24 points

And so on deleting one point per placing down to two points for 26<sup>th</sup> place and every subsequent finisher. One point will be awarded to every non-finisher.

6.2.7 Article 6.1.4 and 6.1.5 also apply.

6.2.8 All drivers are eligible to score points on each round. Points will be awarded to the two highest placed drivers in each team who are classified as finishers and will be added together to make the final event score for the team.

6.2.8 All registered teams are eligible to score points on each round, subsequent to registration. Points will not be awarded for results prior to registration.

6.2.9 All rounds will count toward the final championship total.

6.2.10 Only one car per team may be from Class E classification on each round.

6.2.11 A driver may register as a member of only one team.

### **6.3 Junior Championship**

6.3.1 A 'Junior Driver' is defined as follows:

- a) Was born on or after January 1<sup>st</sup> 1992
- b) Competes in a vehicle with no more than two driven wheels, has an engine capacity of no more than 3000cc and which does not have forced induction (Classes A, B, C and D).

6.3.2 A 'Junior Co-Driver' is defined as follows:

- a) Was born on or after January 1<sup>st</sup> 1992

6.3.3 The points system defined in Article 6.1.3 will be awarded in overall classification order to those eligible.

6.3.4 Article 6.1.4, 6.1.5, 6.1.6, 6.1.7, 6.1.8 and 6.1.9 also apply.

## **7. Publication of Classification**

7.1 Provisional Championship points will be published within seven days following the publication of each round's Final Results, and may additionally be sent to all registered competitors to their registered e-mail address.

## **8. Alteration to Event Format**

8.1 Should it prove impossible to run any round of the Championship in its entirety for any reason, provided that the organisers draw up a Final Official Classification, points will be awarded normally.

## **9. Cancellation of a Qualifying Round**

9.1 Apply Article 6.1.7

9.2 This does not apply to the Teams Championship (Sponsors Cup) where all rounds count.

## **10. Ties**

10.1 If a tie should exist at the season end, it will be decided in favour of the competitor with the greatest number of highest point's scores, then second highest, third highest and so on down to tenth place on the events that made up the competitors final total.

10.2 Should article 10.1 not resolve the tie, it will be decided in the favour of the competitor with the highest point's allocation on the first qualifying round that all competitors concerned started.

10.3 Should article 10.2 not resolve the tie, the position shall be tied.

10.4 This tie-decider applies to the Overall, Class, Junior and Team Championships

## **11. Championship Awards**

11.1	To the Overall winner (Driver)	Manx Rally Championship Shield (perpetual) Sponsors Cup (perpetual) & a replica
	To the Overall winner (Co-Driver)	Manx Rally Championship Shield (perpetual) Sponsors Cup (perpetual) & a replica
	To the winner of each Class (A to E)	a replica
	To the winners of the Teams	Shield (perpetual) and medals for each member
	To the Junior winner (Driver)	a replica
	To the Junior winner (Co-Driver)	a replica

11.2 Overall winners (Driver & Co-Driver) and Class awards are non-cumulative.

## **12. Awards Presentation**

12.1 The presentation for 2017 Championship Awards will be made at the 2017 Annual Dinner and Awards Presentation held at the start of 2018 unless otherwise notified to all registered competitors in a subsequent Bulletin.

## **13. Enforcement of these regulations**

13.1 Disputes regarding these regulations will be settled by the Stewards in accordance with the MSA regulations, these regulations and any additional relevant information issued by either body.

13.2 Any appeals regarding interim results issued after each round must be addressed to the Championship Co-ordinator within 7 days of the results being issued. (See MSA regulation C6.5.1 for Appeals)

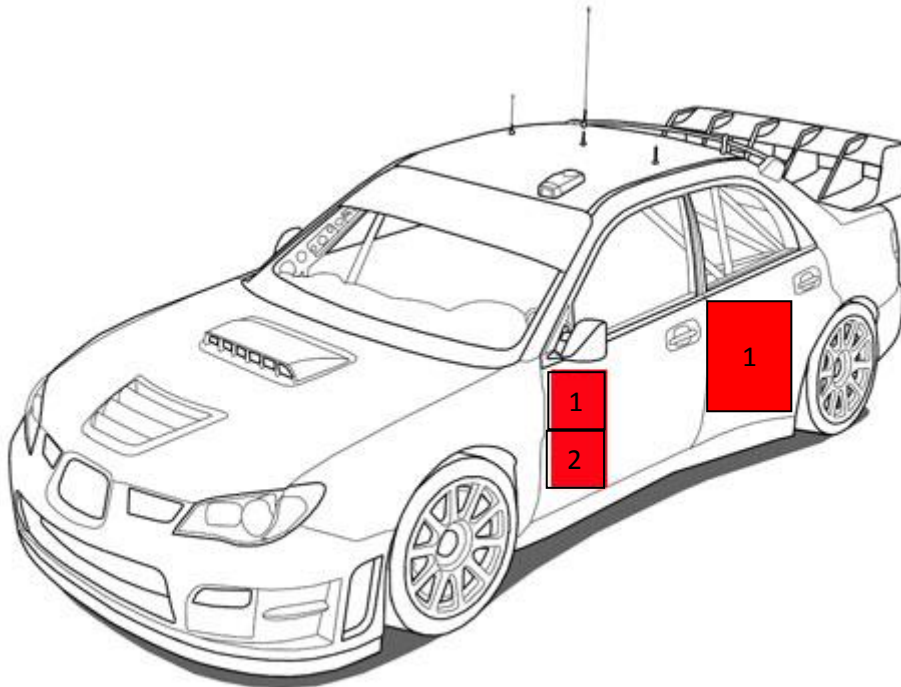
13.3 The date of issue shall be taken as the date of posting on the Championship website.
